



AI Check for Students

Six steps before you rely on an AI answer.

THINKING RULE: THINK FIRST - THEN ASK - AFTERWARDS, VERIFY

1

Clarify your own question

Write down what you already know, suspect and genuinely want to find out.

2

Separate claims from sources

AI can invent sources. Find the origin of important names, figures and quotations.

3

Cross-check independently

Confirm key claims with a reliable source - not merely with a second AI answer.

4

Look for missing perspectives

Ask: Which viewpoint is absent? Could the answer be one-sided, outdated or biased?

5

Protect personal information

Do not share personal, confidential or sensitive information with an AI system.

6

Decide and explain for yourself

Use only what you understand. Explain the result and your decision in your own words.

AI is a tool. The student remains responsible.
